

Understanding Exam Results

Depending on your current status as an AFP judge, your exam results could hold different meanings. Below you can find a guide to discover what your score means for your current judging status. Please understand that "gaining consideration for judging level upgrade" does not mean you have acquired an upgraded status, but rather have begun the process of upgrade evaluation within the AFP judging committee.
